WINEMAKER NOTES

The blend of Pinot Noir from our Edna Ranch estate vineyard creates a refined and balanced Pinot Noir. With each vintage, the blends change creating a unique wine with exceptional depth and complexity. This wine was aged for 9 months in French oak barrels with approximately 30% of them being new.

TASTING NOTES

Deep in color with leading aromas of cedar box and wet forest floor. There are undertones of dried rose petals, smoked savory brisket, and mountain sage. The palate showcases chocolate covered blueberries, dark plum, black candied licorice, eucalyptus and graphite. This vintage is structured to please, and like all classic Pinot Noirs, this wine is at its best with food.

At Tolosa, we are true believers in the special terroir that is Edna Valley, nestled amongst the northwest to southeast running volcanic hills of San Luis Obispo County and the frontier for the most complex cool-climate varietals in California. Our Pinot Noirs and Chardonnays reflect the cold Pacific wind that sweeps down the coast and funnels into the valley, as well as the remarkable diversity of soil types: ingredients for nuanced and balanced wines of distinctive character.
