WINEMAKER NOTES

Bien Nacido Vineyard is located in the Santa Maria Valley, which produces a moderate and long growing season that allows the fruit to take its time to ripen. With these cool conditions, our selected block featuring Chardonnay clone 4 was harvested on October 13th, which was the last lot to be harvested. In addition to the Chardonnay grapes being picked later, this vintage experienced a long and slow fermentation. The wine received great attention and a nurturing winemaking process which brought out more complexities in it. In order to reduce the impact of new oak on the wine, a portion of the Chardonnay was fermented and aged in a puncheon.

ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Sixteen miles from the Pacific Ocean, Bien Nacido benefits from one of the longest growing seasons in California, punctuated by mild sunny days, an afternoon sea breeze and cool, foggy nights and mornings to moderate the temperature of the vines. Additionally, the vineyard is tucked away on the valley floor in a pocket that is cooler than the rest of the valley. The vineyard soils are Elder series which consist of well-drained gravelly loam formed from acid shale and sandstone.
