



# *Topography*



Vineyards are set among rolling benches, low hills, and river terraces with well-drained alluvial soils of gravel, sand, and loam, and are strongly shaped by the cooling influence of Pacific fog.

# *Appellation*




Grapes for this wine came from vineyards planted with the Old Wente clone between Healdsburg and Windsor in the Sonoma Coast AVA.

# *Winemaking*



Grapes for this wine were whole cluster pressed before cold soaking for 2 days at cool temperatures.

# *Fermentation*



Fermentation took place in French oak barriques, of which 20% were new and 80% of this wine went through malolactic fermentation. The wine was then aged for ten months with periodic stirring of the lees in French oak barriques of which 20% were new.
