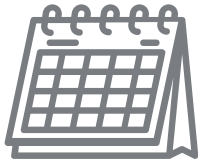


## *Vintage*



The 2022 Russian River Valley growing season brought classic cool-climate conditions with moderate summer temperatures and a steady harvest. Pinot Noir picked on August 22 at 23.6° Brix achieved balanced ripeness and vibrancy.

A touch of leather, fruit leather, smokey, brisket, mushroom and graham cracker. Fruit on dried cherry and cranberry.

## *Palate*



Juicier than expected from the nose. Touch of rose, dark cherry, baking cacao. Medium body, velvety texture. Acidity brings a nice freshness, maybe even tartness. Finishes on earthy notes.
