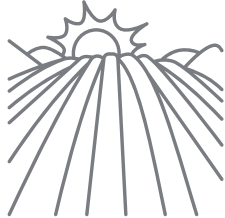


## *Topography*



Grapes for this wine came primarily from our Salaal Vineyard, known for its rich clay soils and slightly warmer growing conditions.

## *Appellation*



Located in the San Luis Obispo AVA, Salaal Vineyard grapes with warmer weather and clay loam and sandy soils were complimented by the Lemons and Vines Block located at the base of the Santa Lucia Mountains, a cooler site with rockier soils.

## *Winemaking*



This wine is 97% Syrah and 3% Petite Sirah. After destemming and optical sorting, grapes were cold soaked for three days at cooler temperatures before fermentation in an open top stainless steel tank.

## *Fermentation*



After fermentation, the wine was aged for 18 months in 100% French oak barrels, 36% new.
