



## *Topography*



Grenache is grown in stony, sedimentary loam soils at Morro View Vineyard, while Syrah comes from deep clay soils at our Salaal Vineyard on Edna Ranch and the sandy loam soils of Spanish Springs Vineyard, set among rolling hills in a narrow coastal canyon.

## *Appellation*




All grapes for the 2022 Salaal are from Edna Valley. Grenache is sourced from the organically farmed Morro View Vineyard, while Syrah comes from our Salaal Vineyard on Edna Ranch and Spanish Springs Vineyard near the coast.

## *Winemaking*



The 2022 Salaal is a blend of 66% Syrah and 34% Grenache. Grapes were destemmed, optically sorted and then cold soaked for three days at moderate temperatures.

## *Fermentation*



Fermentation took place in 100% open top, stainless steel tanks followed by aging for 18 months in 75% French oak barriques and 25% French oak puncheons, 25% were new barrels.
