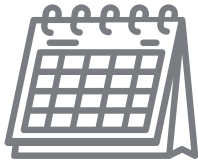


## *Vintage*

## *Sight*



Brilliant, vibrant yellow with subtle green reflections.

## *Nose*



Fresh and youthful, offering notes of pear, melon, and papaya, layered with hints of white flowers, brioche, and a touch of minerality.

## *Palate*



Medium-bodied, featuring flavors of Gala apple and honeydew melon, supported by lively acidity and nuanced undertones of chalk, oats, and dried lemon.
