WINEMAKER NOTES

The blend of separate blocks of our Edna Ranch estate vineyards create a refined and balanced Pinot Noir. With each vintage, the blends change creating a unique wine with exceptional depth and complexity. This wine was aged for 9 months in French oak barrels with approximately 30% of them being new.

TASTING NOTES

Deep red cherry color with nuanced aromas of clay and river rock. This wine has expressive aromas of red cherry and raspberry that showcase a punchy ripe fruit characteristic on the palate. Flavors exhibit notes of cola, strawberry seeds, rhubarb, leather and a hint of eucalyptus. At this youthful stage, this wine offers soft approachable tannins that linger on the finish.
