At Tolosa, we are true believers in the special terroir that is Edna Valley, nestled amongst the northwest to southeast running volcanic hills of San Luis Obispo County and the frontier for the most complex cool-climate varietals in California. Our Pinot Noirs and Chardonnays reflect the cold Pacific wind that sweeps down the coast and funnels into the valley, as well as the remarkable diversity of soil types: ingredients for nuanced and balanced wines of distinctive character.

WINEMAKER NOTES

We made our 1772 Rosé by applying the saignee technique of bleeding a touch of juice off the skins on a few of our tanks of estate Pinot Noir. The juice was then fermented in a small stainless steel tank with a strain of yeast known to enhance the fruity and floral aromas. Post fermentation, the wine was transferred to stainless steel drums for aging, giving us the ability to stir the lees and enhance a richer mouth-feel.

ABOUT THE VINEYARD

Location is everything, and Edna Valley has it all. The multitude of soils in our Edna Ranch already guarantees that no two blocks of Pinot Noir will taste the same. Our topography and resulting climate offer even more complexity in our grapes while maintaining the natural acidity, as the transverse valley provides a moderating marine influence which allows an extended growing season and cooler temperatures. This unique terroir is showcased perfectly in our 1772 Rosé.

Color	Pale pink with copper highlights
On the Nose	Crushed Graham crackers, raspberry puree, rose hip and a bounty of floral notes starting with rose petals, then delicate orange blossom, and finishing with Lily of the Valley.
On the Palate	An ethereal wine with diverse flavors of watermelon rind, rose water, strawberry seed and dragon fruit. The mouth-watering acidity carries all the way through. A lingering finish with notes of saline and lychee.
