2017 CHARDONNAY, EDNA RANCH, POLETTI The nose is rich, ripe and dense white currant, peach and soft red apple flesh. The palate offers elegant lemon, caramel and crème brulee, with notes of dry mineral. Drink 2019 – 2024. **2017 CHARDONNAY, BIEN NACIDO VINEYARD** The nose is delicate and well-focused crème brulee, tropical fruits, citrus, hay and lanolin. The palate is classic dry saline, crushed rock and lemon with underlying notes of lean acidity. A very attractive wine that should age well. Drink 2020 – 2030. **2017 PINOT NOIR, EDNA RANCH, PRIMERA** The nose is ripe, polished blackberry, savory tapenade and tobacco. The palate is finely focused red and black stone fruits with impressively layered lushness in the core – florals, mountain strawberry finishing with dry cocoa bean. Drink 2020 – 2027. **2017 PINOT NOIR, EDNA RANCH, HOLLISTER** The nose is dry strawberry and juicy blackberry that gains dimension in a core punctuated with sticky berries and notes of blossoms. The palate is well-focused and vibrant red berries on entry that builds intensity to a fuller-bodied core of sleek concentration, finishing with a long, textured dry raspberry. Drink 2020 – 2027.
