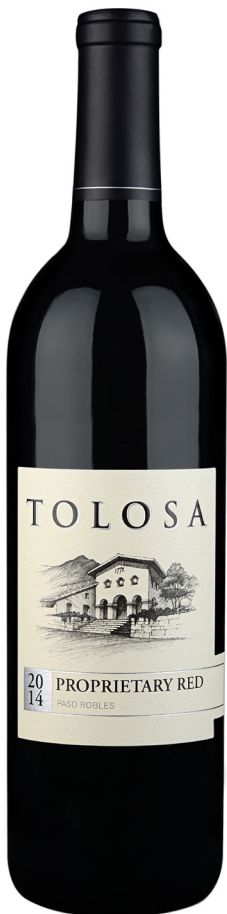

5% Petite Sirah, 2% Grenache

AGING

Fermented in stainless steel tanks and aged for 18 months in small French oak barrels.

Paso Robles

WINEMAKER NOTES

The Cabernet Sauvignon and Petite Verdot grapes for this wine were sourced from carefully-selected sites in the Paso Robles AVA. The Cabernet Sauvignon comes from both Meeker Vineyards, which has sandy loam soils, and Paso Ono Vineyard, where the Petit Verdot is grown as well. The wine was fermented in stainless steel tanks and aged for 18 months in small French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Deep black cherry color with aromas of sage brush, cigar and sandalwood along with notes of clove and menthol. Enticing flavors of red currant, rhubarb, strawberry jam, black plum and fig. Hints of graphite on the back palate welcome the fine-grain tannins that linger on the finish. This elegant and approachable Proprietary Red Blend would pair well with a roast tenderloin.
