### WINEMAKER NOTES

The blend of Pinot Noir from our Edna Ranch estate vineyard creates a refined and balanced Pinot Noir. With each vintage, the blends change creating a unique wine with exceptional depth and complexity. This wine was aged for 9 months in French oak barrels with approximately 30% of them being new.

### TASTING NOTES

Ruby in color with nuanced aromas of graham cracker, black cherry, cola, raspberry purée, with an underlying earthy note of fennel. The wine exhibits a ripe plumpness of fleshy plum with supporting aromas of flint, blood orange, and tea leaves. This wine has velvety tannins that linger on the finish.
